

# Victoria State Rose Garden Heritage Rose Border

Selections from Rose groups significant in the development of the genus *Rosa*. are featured in this garden at Werribee Park. There are roses originating from all around the world, important old Australian raised cultivars, and 'old style' English Roses. These compliment the modern roses of the Tudor Rose section.

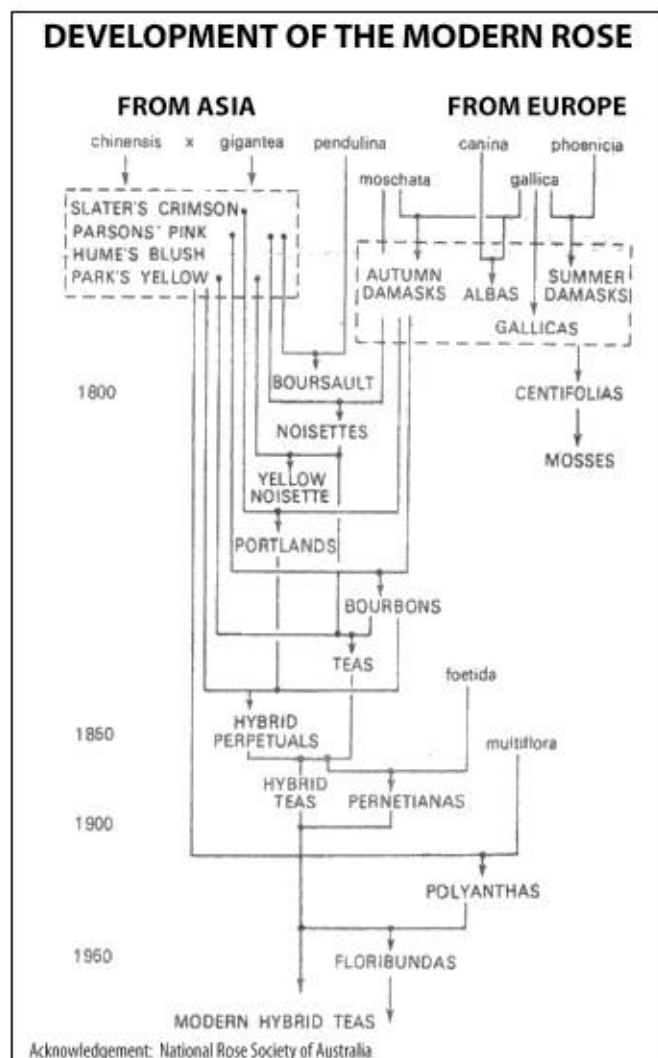


\*\* Name bricks on bed border edging relate to roses in front part of garden. Name bricks located in garden beds relate to roses on the fence line.

## Species Roses – Where it all began

Roses like all cultivated plants are bred or developed by chance from wild or species parents. The rose family history includes species material from throughout the northern hemisphere.

More than one hundred species and comparable number of natural crossbreeds have been found from snow covered Alaska to the harsh desert climate of Mexico. Throughout the continents of the northern hemisphere, each species has adapted to the rigours of its own environment. There are NO naturally occurring Australian rose species.



## Old Fashioned, Old Garden or Heritage? <sup>1</sup>

There are many roses with an "old fashioned" appearance (button-eye, quilled, quartered, cupped or ruffled), but ALL these types, as well as single, semi-single or tea rose forms, can be found among the Modern Roses as they also can among Old Garden Roses. There are two dates of significance with respect to the definitions provided by the World Federation of Rose Societies (WFRS), of which HRIA <sup>2</sup> is an Associate Member.

(a) An Old Garden Rose is one which belongs to a type that was in existence before 1867; this is the date attributed to the introduction of the first Hybrid Tea, **La France**, accepted as the first Modern Rose. This is regardless of its date of introduction

(b) A Heritage Rose is one which was introduced before 1900, regardless of type or classification

Thus, any Tea Rose is an Old Garden Rose, regardless of its date of introduction, because the Tea Rose class pre-dates the first Hybrid Tea and any Hybrid Tea is a Modern Rose even if it were introduced before 1900.

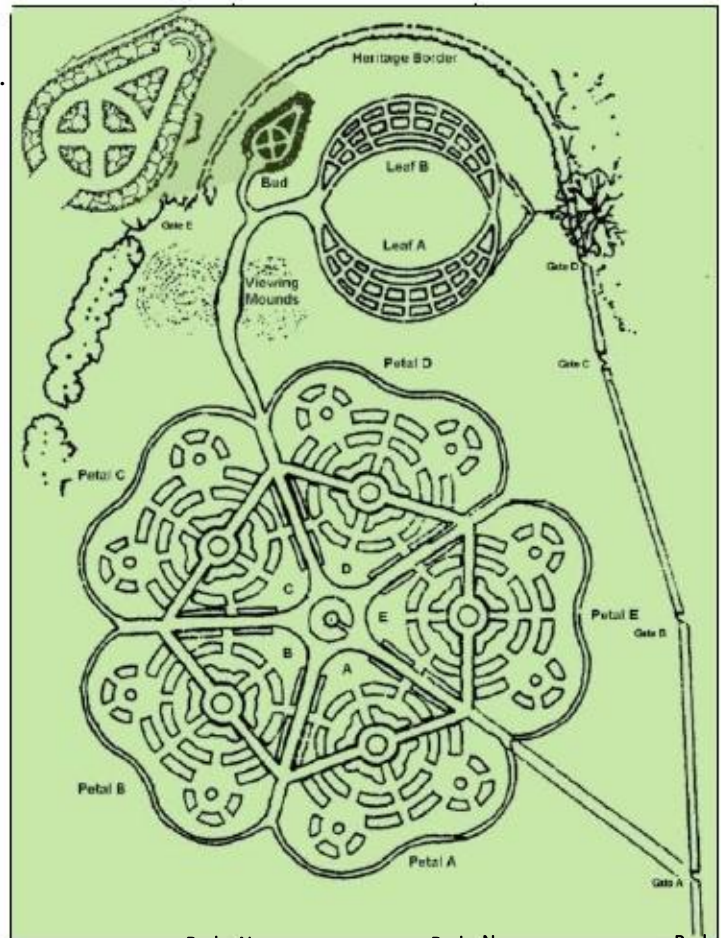
